POUNING NAILS IN THE FLOOR WITH MY FOREHEAD by Eric Bogosian

In the first of the UGA Department of Theatre and Film Studies's™ new Student Production schedule, senior Theatre major Piotr Stapor will be performing the one-man show POUNDING NAILS IN THE FLOOR WITH MY FOREHEAD on November 6 and 7 in the Arena Theatre. Written and originally performed in 1994 by Obie-winning artist Eric Bogosian, POUNDING NAILS aims scorching social commentary at the contemporary urban and suburban scene. Throughout the performance, Stapor will take on the personas of eleven different twisted individuals, from subway panhandlers to barbecue-crazed millionaires, each more unsavory than the one before, as they all struggle against the larger machinations of the world about them. Through his depictions of these characters' ultimately futile ranting against the darkly humorous quirks of life, Stapor attacks theatre's greatest mystery - what it means to be human.
