Robert Woodruff co-founded the Eureka Theatre, where he served as Artistic and Resident Director until 1978. In 1976 Woodruff established his second theatre, the Bay Area Playwrights Festival, a summer forum for the development of new plays that is still flourishing. From 2001-2007, Woodruff served as Artistic Director of the American Repertory Theatre at Harvard University. Robert Woodruff is one of the country's most versatile stage directors. His theatrical vocabulary encompasses a remarkable range of styles, from the naturalistic simplicity of his productions of Shepard and Bond to his baroque deconstructions of Shakespeare and Brecht. Woodruff collaborates with living playwrights and revisits the masterpieces of the classical canon with equal flair. After thirty years of directing, Woodruff continues to develop fresh dramatic forms with each production.
